


Reaching Your Fundraising Goal

When you sign up for Cycle Camelot through the website, you will be taken to Canada Helps to set up your personal or team fundraising page. Through the registration process, you will establish a fundraising goal (\$200 or more) and be asked to share your story. We are asking that each participant make an initial donation of \$50 to kick start your fundraising and help cover the cost of making Cycle Camelot 2016 a fun and safe event. Each person that contributes to your fundraising goal will receive an email of thanks from the GBCSC, however, if you prefer to also send them an email, please select the box that sends you notifications every time someone donates to your personal or team page. Once your page is set up you can now share it with friends, family and coworkers! Be sure to send donors to your TEAM page if you are fundraising as a group.

Using your personal email account, you can share your story with friends, family and coworkers, and copy and paste the link to your personal or team fundraising page in your email. You can also encourage people to visit www.cyclecamelot.com and they can find you on the site by clicking on Sponsor a Cyclist or Team and entering in your name. Sending emails everytime you reach a notable fundraising benchmark (50%, 75%, 90%, goal reach!) will remind your supporters to contribute.
